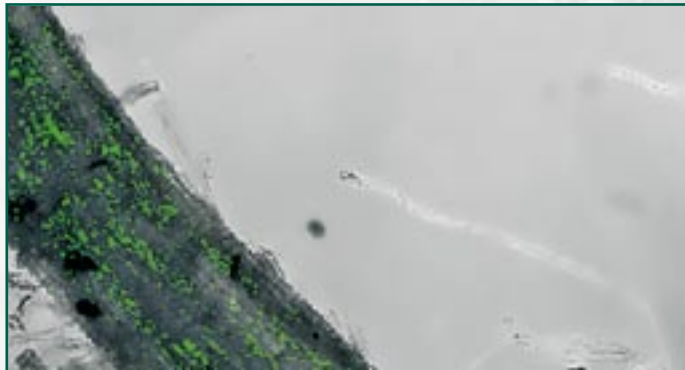
To elucidate the functions and physiology of these newly described members of the microbial world and their role in the microbial community network belongs to the decadal grand challenges.
